- Dr. Hersch felt very biased in his teaching. I felt like if I disagreed with his viewpoint on a subject matter I got a lower mark on my weekly paper than if I just sucked it up and agreed, even if that's not how I truly felt. He also taught under the assumption that everyone had the same viewpoint as he did, which was certainly not true.
- Maybe use less lecture during class and switch up activities. Also, try to make this class a 50 minute class 3 times a week rather than an hour 15 2 times a week. The extra time is painful to sit through for this class.
- · Overall great instructor
- · Fun class, hot topics of conversation
- Well, the course was based upon participation in groups as well as aloud. But, if our views did not coincide with yours or at least did not acknowledge your view, then it would be shut down and you wouldn't acknowledge ours. I understand that a global ethics class is liberal for the most part, but you would make a joke of any other view that was not liberal. I am not even conservative per say, I would consider myself independent; but this class turned me off from being liberal because of your non-chalant approach to both point of views. "I'm not saying that my opinion is right, but the other view is pretty ludacris if you ask me," is a direct quote from a highly debated topic in the world currently. I like that you encouraged group participation and getting involved, but I don't understand how you can project that notion when you don't consider any other side that isn't your own/your parties. I believe you are a good guy, but consider going at the class with a neutral standpoint to prevent people coming to class only to avoid a ridiculous participation grade deduction.
- Although I do not believe Dr. Hersch means any harm, but sometimes his delivery is terrible. Its very intimidating to answer questions in front of the class because it never seems like there is "the right answer." I talked to many students in the class struggled with understanding concepts that Dr. Hersch presented. So, answering questions about difficult concepts was challenging because Dr. Hersch's feedback wasn't always constructive but sometimes rude. I also did not like a comment Dr. Hersch said at the start of the semester. Dr. Hersch told our class that we should not put our names on our papers due to bias. He continued by saying there is bias in all grading and gave the example of bias by who was "pretty" or "tall". I found this comment among others to be unnecessary. Finally, Dr. Hersch makes his opinion very clear in a pompous manner, and its hard to have your own opinion (as a student) when you know the professor already doesn't agree with you. I hope this feedback will help Dr. Hersch when dealing with students in the future.
- · Sometimes the lectures were kind of boring and I think it would help to include more videos or even like scenarios regarding ethics.

- Professor Hersch was a very competent professor. Our class did not speak often but the conversation questions posed about the topics were helpful to furthering my understanding of the material.
- I think for next year you should have more interactive activities in class to get the points across. This course could be very interesting based off of the material we learn, but the material needs to be presented in a way that students stay interested. I think another issue is that this class was only Monday and Wednesday, so the class was longer and therefore it was easier to lose the attention of the students. If this class becomes more interactive I think the learning environment would be more enjoyable and effective.
- Prof. Hersch was very kind and fair to all of the opinions and issues we discussed in class. It was helpful!

- Honestly, I would say shuffle up the groups for discussion, as it would allow students to hear different perspectives each class.

- I wouldn't use the point system anymore just because its hard to calculate your actual grade for this class.
- He didn't explain basic things well, but could explain abstract things. It was kind of hard to exactly follow along.
- I enjoyed the content of this course and I genuinely enjoyed being in class and hearing Gil's lectures and other students thoughts. He had great ideas and was an interesting professor, who clearly enjoyed discussing the topics. Unfortunately, because this is an introductory philosophy class, I was extremely surprised by his expectations and what I believe to be unrealistic grading. I felt that he often failed to explain his expectations for essays, resulting in it feeling very hard to earn a good grade. Attending office hours definitely helped though, but even so, I felt it was very difficult to get a good grade on papers, especially considering this is an introductory class and many people have no prior experience with philosophy. I also feel the grading scale is a bit ridiculous. The way he has the grading structured makes it very easy to avoid failing, but almost impossible to achieve an A. To get an A, you'd have to get a 100% on every single assignment, exam, essay, and considering he is a tough grader, I would say achieving this would be near impossible. It was very discouraging and disappointing as I enjoyed this course but felt it was impossible to be as successful as I wanted to be no matter how hard I worked.
- I thought the class was boring. I did not like the material. It was dry and was not stimulating. I think there should have been more discussions based on current events in regards to morality and justice.
